Guests can now book bus segments as a part of their air travel itinerary directly on suncountry.com. Connections with Landline are on sale now with fares starting as low as \$81* one-way for Mankato, and \$91* one-way for Duluth to Las Vegas. Service begins November 4, operating five daily roundtrips between Mankato and MSP, and four daily roundtrips between Duluth and MSP.
